Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to advise the Commission that UTAM, Inc., the FCC designated frequency coordinator for the Unlicensed Personal Communications (“UPCS”) has fully wound up its affairs and is now dissolved. As the FCC is aware, UTAM had been remaining in operation pending receipt of certain FCC-mandated clearing reimbursements from the AWS-H Block licensees. Once that money was received, UTAM was able to fully discharge all of its remaining cost-sharing obligations with respect to the 1910-1930 MHz band and cease operations.

UTAM has now, in fact, paid off all of the remaining cost-sharing obligations it owes, repaid all other debts and obligations, and, consistent with its non-profit status, donated all remaining funds to a selection of recognized national charities. Accordingly, on April 6, 2015, the Court of Chancery of the State of Delaware granted UTAM’s petition for dissolution and on April 23, 2015, UTAM held its final Board of Directors meeting. UTAM is now dissolved.
