Red River Rural Telephone Association (“Company”) hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering wireline broadband internet access service on a tariff basis. Effective July 1, 2015 Red River Rural Telephone Association will begin offering wireline broadband internet access service on a Title II, common-carriage, permissive detariffed basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission’s Wireline Broadband Order.¹ The geographic areas affect are those Red River Rural Telephone Association exchanges where DSL is technically feasible.

Today, this service is provided to Red River Rural Telephone Association. The ISP purchases wireline broadband access service for use as a component in their broadband internet service sold to residential and business customers. End user services provided will not be affected by discontinuance of the tariffed offering by Red River Rural Telephone Association. As stated in the attached customer notice, Red River Rural Telephone Association will continue to offer existing ISP customers under current rates, terms and conditions until the end of their current term or upon replacement with a Broadband Commercial Agreement. Red River Rural Telephone Association’s rates, terms and conditions for its permissively detariffed wireline broadband access service will be available at its office located at 510 Broadway, Abercrombie, ND 58001 and on its website at www.rrt.net.


Dear Valued Customer:

Our records indicate that Red River Rural Telephone Association is currently purchasing wholesale broadband transport services from Red River Rural Telephone Association under NECA Tariff No. 5 ("Tariff"). This letter is to inform you that Red River Rural Telephone Association study area 381631 will no longer offer DSL services under the Tariff effective July 1, 2015. Services will be made available to you on a common carrier, non-tariffed basis.

Red River Rural Telephone Association's rates, terms and conditions for its non-tariffed wireline broadband access service can and will be available at its office located at 510 Broadway, Abercrombie, ND and on its website at www.rrt.net.

The actions described above are take in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order (FCC 15-150) released September 23, 2005 in Docket No. 02-33. In the order, the FCC determined that facilities-based wireline broadband internet service providers could offer their services on a common carrier, permissively detariffed basis.
