NYC Charter HS for Architecture, Engineering, and Construction Industries is requesting an appeal to USAC's decision not to hear an appeal regarding Funding Requests 2606577, 2606611, 2606605, 2606602, and 2631090.

The denial of Form 471 #959586, was based on the applicant not providing requested information to USAC. A request that was not received by the school nor consultant. USAC then refused to hear an appeal to this denial based on 60 days having passed since a FDCL. However, the school was again not notified by USAC of any decision being made regarding the application. The FDCL was only brought to the attention of the applicant by a concerned vendor.

We therefore argue that USAC failed to notify the applicant of a deadline for the appeals process, and that the 60 day timeframe should not be applied in examining the appeal of a denial of funding.
