RE: Docket 02-33 – Notice of Permissive De-tariffing of Wireline Broadband and Internet Access Service by Armstrong Telephone Company – PA (Study Area: 170189)

This memo is to advise you that Armstrong Telephone Company – PA (the “Company”) will discontinue provisioning broadband transport services on July 1, 2015 from the NECA Tariff No. 5. The Company currently provides broadband transport services in the local telephone exchanges of Clinton, PA as well as the surrounding rural areas in Pennsylvania. No action is required on your part. Please be advised that broadband transport services will be available to you on a common carrier, non-tariffed basis. The existing relevant rates, terms and conditions will not change until the end of your existing term or upon replacement of a new agreement under the de-tariffed pricing, terms, and conditions.

Effective July 1, 2015 the new rates, term, and conditions for broadband transport services will be available in printed copy during normal business hours at the Company’s business office located at 1755 State Route 30, Clinton, PA 15026 or on our website at: www.armstrongonewire.com/support/tariffs.
