

On May 11, 2015, the Enforcement Bureau (“Bureau”) submitted an Unopposed Request Regarding Cablevision’s Motion for Summary Decision (“Request”). The Bureau requests that the Presiding Judge modify the briefing schedule with respect to the Motion for Summary Decision filed by Cablevision Systems Corp. to allow the Bureau to submit its comments within seven days of the filing of an opposition by Game Show Network, LLC (“GSN”). The Bureau believes this will lead to greater efficiency and decrease the likelihood that repetitive arguments will be submitted into the record.

The Presiding Judge agrees with the Bureau and grants its Request. As GSN filed its Opposition to Cablevision Systems Corporation’s Motion for Summary Decision on May 13, 2015, the Bureau shall submit its comments on or before May 20, 2015.
