Re: Extremely Urgent – Asking for immediate intervention in protecting our intellectual property and technology from the AT&T/Direct TV Merger; ultimately not approving the merger until the issues are resolved

Dear Chairman Tom Wheeler,

My name is Erik Underwood, CEO of My24HourNews.Com, Inc. headquartered here in Denver, Colorado. I am asking you and the Federal Communications Commission to step in and put the AT&T/Direct TV merger on hold; while we sort out serious issues raised in our pending federal lawsuit. **My24HourNews.Com, Inc. opposes the merger in its current state.** AT&T has proposed using our technology in the Direct TV merger; through conversion AT&T has resorted to theft of our Intellectual Property and Technology. In the Form 8K filing on May 19th, 2014, AT&T and Direct TV in their merger agreement, agreed to settle any legal claims arising out of the merger prior to closing. It is incumbent upon all involved parties to aggressively hold those provisions true to this situation.

Furthermore, for over two years, AT&T has prevented My24 from launching and entering the marketplace with our unique technology. In order for AT&T to prevent My24 from using our technology, AT&T fraudulently billed My24 for non-existent network charges in excess of \$400,000. In order for the network charges to be valid, My24 has to be launched and obviously we have not launched yet. AT&T in effect does not want My24 to compete with them using our own technology that they shut us out from using. This would obviously give AT&T a superior advantage in the marketplace; by using illegal and unfair business practices. The fraudulent debt that AT&T placed on My24 hurt our ability to launch and enter the marketplace. AT&T demanded payment from My24 and used that ploy to try and change terms of our joint venture agreement. To date, AT&T has refused to release our technology and intellectual property to My24. Notwithstanding our other concerns, **My24 did not give AT&T and Direct TV permission** to use our concept, intellectual property, and technology in this merger.

AT&T does not want My24 to enter the marketplace with technology we invented; that customizes users' preferences in regards to mobile digital content. The technology is an industry game changer. We believe AT&T has violated anti-competition and telecommunication laws of this country; notwithstanding parts of the Clayton Act. We need this agency to act accordingly. If AT&T is allowed to merge with Direct TV using our concept and technology; that will greatly hurt My24's ability to compete in the marketplace. Inaction in regards to public interest; will undermine public confidence in intellectual property protection and fair competition. AT&T will try to minimize this relationship as a vendor and customer dispute: that cannot be further from the truth. We will be happy to provide you with the facts and supporting evidence. Please see attached e-mails. The emails that we are providing are not indicative of all the evidence we have; it just shows part of the relationship we had with AT&T.

My24HourNews.Com is a digital news network for mobile, internet, and tablet applications. We also developed a cable TV version of My24 that will launch in the future as well. Not only is My24 a digital content creation company which currently focuses on news, we also created digital technology for our content to be distributed on mobile platforms. In part, the technology that we created allows users to customize their user preference on our platform; delivering specific news content at any time of the day or hour to their mobile devices in HD video. My24 has been in a joint venture partnership with AT&T since 2011. We created the technology and platform with AT&T, with all intellectual property rights going to My24 under this agreement.



In closing, AT&T illegally suppressed our company's ability to launch through anti-competitive measures which also includes conversion. AT&T must be held accountable and certainly not merge using our intellectual property. This country has a great history of protecting intellectual property rights from theft and anti-competitive practices. This unfortunate matter cannot undermine legitimate competition and innovation. Subsequently, if unchecked, I fear this will greatly damage the trust and operation of our system. Our legal counsel and I can provide you with any documents as you investigate; we will also make ourselves available anytime to the FCC's inquiry on this matter. Please enter this letter into the official record regarding the AT&T/Direct TV merger review by the FCC (Please also keep the attached e-mails confidential in the record).
