**ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S SUBMISSION
REGARDING CABLEVISION'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY DECISION**

1. On April 30, 2015, Cablevision Systems Corp. (Cablevision) filed a Motion for Summary Decision (Motion) in the above-captioned matter. On May 11, 2015, the Enforcement Bureau (Bureau) respectfully requested that the Presiding Judge modify the briefing schedule with respect to Cablevision's Motion to allow the Bureau to submit its comments, if any, on the Motion within seven calendar (7) days after Game Show Network, LLC (GSN) filed its opposition thereto.¹ The Bureau argued that such a modification of the briefing schedule would lead to greater efficiency and less likelihood of repetitive arguments in the record.² The Presiding Judge agreed, and granted the Bureau until May 20, 2015 to submit its comments.³

2. The Bureau has now carefully reviewed Cablevision's Motion and GSN's


