

On May 15, 2015, Reed Hundt, representing LightSquared LLC, and Ivan Seidenberg, who is expected to serve as chairman of New LightSquared's board, met with Chairman Tom Wheeler, Philip Verveer, and Renee Gregory. Mr. Hundt discussed the status of various proceedings before the Commission as well as the activities of other agencies in matters relating to LightSquared. Messrs. Hundt and Seidenberg underscored the need for the Commission to move forward promptly so that this vital L-Band spectrum can be used for broadband terrestrial services and that spectrum located at 1675-1680 MHz can be made available for terrestrial services.
