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The internet is a tool used by a massive sum of American People, Businesses, and Nonprofit organizations. With this in mind, any form of manipulation concerning the cost or speed of such an intricate part of the NATION'S personal, business (financial), and social structures is absolutely absurd.

Furthermore, the American economy is based upon the capability of production in each aspect of business: communication, production, transportation, and sales. The internet directly impacts each of these aspects of the American economy (ex. commercials on each website, production of online resources, transportation of information, and online purchasing).

The oligopoly of internet providers must be publically identified and controlled immediately. There can be NO RESTRICTIONS on speed AND NO DEMANDS for tiered price structure based on willingness to pay exorbitant amounts of money.
