Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 20, 2015, representatives of AT&T Services, Inc. (AT&T), specifically Mary Henze, David Hostetter and the undersigned, met with Jonathan Lechter of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the anticipated Lifeline Reform Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPRM) in the above referenced docket.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the reform of the Lifeline program and specifically changes to all Lifeline resale requirements including those proposed in the 2012 FNPRM. AT&T supports the proposed changes as long as LEC Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETCs) are able to continue to be reimbursed from USAC for resold lifeline services during the time needed to execute any necessary contract changes. AT&T also reiterated its support for limiting reimbursement to those lifeline providers who have the end user relationship with the customer.
