Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Zayo Group Holdings, Inc. (“Zayo”), I write to request that the Federal Communications Commission move forward to adopt its proposed rules in the referenced proceeding in order to provide much needed additional mobile broadband capacity in the 2.4 GHz band.

Zayo is a global provider of bandwidth infrastructure services, including dark fiber, live video, wavelengths, SONET, Ethernet, IP and colocation services. Our network footprint extends over 84,000 route miles, with connectivity on dense metro and intercity fiber assets. Zayo was founded in 2007 and is headquartered in Boulder, Colorado, with European headquarters in London and Paris. Zayo’s network serves eight countries and 46 states, plus Washington D.C. The network connects the largest U.S. and European cities, as well as many Tier 2–5 U.S. markets. Zayo’s network reaches approximately 17,500 buildings, including over 800 data centers, nearly 4,000 cell towers, and over 10,000 enterprise buildings.


