On May 27, 2015, representatives of the Association for Public Television Stations, AT&T, Competitive Carriers Association, CTIA – The Wireless Association, National Association of Broadcasters, the Public Broadcasting Service, Sprint, T-Mobile, and Verizon met with Commission staff. During this meeting, NAB and APTS discussed some of the potential challenges associated with the process of repacking broadcasters following the incentive auction.
