Subject: Comments Pertinent to Satellite Television
Provider(s) and Wyoming PBS

My family and I live in Teton County, Wyoming and until just recently subscribed to Dish Network for our television viewing. Sadly, we could not watch Wyoming PBS programming with this provider.

That we could not view Wyoming PBS with Dish Network, or any satellite TV provider, is wrong. Wyoming PBS broadcasts local programs on our state government, environmental situations, Wyoming cultural and sports events, state news, weather conditions and warnings, and much more. Wyoming taxpayers need access to many programs from their public broadcasting station.

I strongly urge that the Federal Communications Commission's "local into local" rule be changed such that all satellite television providers must include the state public broadcasting station for the geographic location of all their viewers. In our case, we should have been able to select Wyoming PBS when using Dish Network.
