Dear FCC,

The following is my transcription of the unwanted and unsolicited telephone call I received yesterday afternoon, Thursday, April 9, 2015. Any thinking person could easily construe the call as either bait towards some future settlement/monies, or fishing for information and/or monies.

The prerecorded telephone call was received on my home landline (i.e., wired) telephone, which is registered on the Federal Do Not Call List, and was time stamped 4:35 pm on Thursday, April 9, 2015 by my voicemail service and Caller ID indicated the following:

Texas Caller 817-760-4158

My transcription follows:

“This is Thomas Swordorski (? unsure of caller’s exact last name) from the Pretrial Investigation Unit for Berkshire Recovery Services. I need to speak to (here another man’s prerecorded voice said “Allen Morin”).

You have been named in an investigation at this time regarding a date incident where you have been cited for violations of the USC Title Code 18, Section 1344. Due to your blatant disregard to respond to the allegations, we need a statement from yourself or your attorney within 72 hours. Failure to contact us will result in further information to be forwarded to your local jurisdiction. Please contact us at 844-662-8940 to speak to an investigator. You have been officially notified.”

When I returned home Thursday evening, I called 844-662-8940, the number cited by the caller, but no one answered.

I called 844-662-8940 at 11:20 am on Friday, April 10, 2015 and a lady who said her name is Lisa answered. She said their business name is Berkshire Recovery. She asked which phone numbers they had called us on and I replied with the two phone numbers: 817-788-2870 which is our home phone, and 817-449-3500 which is my wife Kathleen’s cell phone.

She kept asking for further information, at which time I asked if they had a Do Not Call list. She said they did not have such a list in their office. I then asked that they stop calling us and hung up.

These kinds of calls are getting more and more onerous and hateful and I ask that the FCC do something positive to bring these robocalls to an end. As information, both of my phone numbers, listed above, are registered on the Federal Do Not Call List.

I am also sending this letter, which is an attachment to my FCC Call Complaint, which is being sent to the FCC today, to the following Texas Congressional delegates and am herein requesting their action to stop these kinds of unwanted and unwarranted robocalls:
