
COMMENTS OF SUMARRASE, INC.

1. Sumarrase, Inc., permittee of low power FM station WSGD-LP, Facility ID 194387, Lehigh Acres, Florida, supports REC Networks' proposals in the above-captioned petition for rulemaking and would like to encourage the FCC to begin a formal rulemaking proceeding at an early date.

2. We are looking very much forward to putting our station on the air and operating it to serve the public. However, FM spectrum is tightly packed along the southwest coast of Florida, where we are located. The engineering work we had to undertake to find a channel was complicated, and we had to deal with second-adjacent channel interference. We feel that a higher limit and more flexibility to change our transmitter site would give us better tools to address interference issues in the future and to enable us to carry our station to the next level.


