On May 29, 2015, Austin Schlick and Staci Pies of Google Inc., and I spoke via telephone with Ruth Milkman, FCC Chief of Staff, and Renee Gregory, Legal Advisor for Chairman Wheeler, about the above-referenced proceedings. We discussed the importance of consumers having reliable access to three or more channels that permit the use of unlicensed devices. In addition, we discussed the study that Google filed on May 22, 2015, which demonstrates that unlicensed devices can operate in the duplex gap and on Channel 37 without causing harmful interference to licensees.<sup>1</sup>
