Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 1, 2015, Kathleen Abernathy, Executive Vice President, External Affairs, Frontier Communications ("Frontier"), and I met with Commissioner Michael O'Rielly and Amy Bender, Wireline Advisor to Commissioner Michael O'Rielly.

The parties discussed Frontier's efforts in deploying broadband to Americans living in rural areas under Phase I of the Connect America Fund ("CAF"). In particular, the parties discussed the attached press release, including the extensive progress that Frontier has made in deploying broadband to 93,000 unserved locations under CAF Phase I Round 1 and deploying or upgrading broadband service to more than 103,000 locations as part of CAF Phase I Round 2. Frontier's representatives also explained that the next phase of CAF funding, CAF Phase II, will enable Frontier and other price cap carriers to accelerate broadband investment in high cost, unserved markets across America.
