I am writing pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules to report that on June 3, 2015, Edwin N. Lavergne (representing the Catholic Technology Network, CTN), Evan Carb (representing the Hispanic Information and Telecommunications Network, Inc., HITN) and the undersigned (representing the National EBS Association, NEBSA) met with John Leibovitz and Sean Conway of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Blaise A. Scinto, John Schauble and Nancy Zaczek of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's Broadband Division, regarding the referenced proceeding. During the meeting, we discussed aspects of the June 6, 2014 "Consensus Proposal" of CTN, NEBSA, HITN and the Wireless Communications Association International, Inc. for licensing currently unlicensed Educational Broadband Service ("EBS") spectrum. We also discussed other possible changes and/or updates to FCC rules, including the educational use requirements for EBS.
