We are a community-run nonprofit organization that received an LPFM 100 license in October of 2014. We are an all-volunteer station currently broadcasting online and hope to be on 97.1 FM by the end of this year. We serve a diverse and often under-represented population in Louisville. We offer news, multi-cultural programming, and information about community nonprofits throughout our broadcasting day. We are prepared to provide local emergency broadcasting services should they become necessary. A power upgrade to 250 watts would enable us to reach a wider range of the Louisville population with the news and information that matters to them most.
