On behalf of The Nielsen Company (US) LLC, on 3 June 2015, I had brief conversations regarding this matter by telephone with Chanelle Hardy, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Clyburn, Travis Litman and Jennifer Thompson, advisors to Commissioner Rosenworcel, and Mark Stone, Deputy Chief of the Consumer & Governmental Affairs Bureau. In each of these conversations I said the forthcoming Order in this docket should be sufficiently clear that it does not alter existing law holding that wireless calls dialed by hand from a device that, at the time the calls were made, was unable to autodial wireless numbers, are not covered by the TCPA.
