We are writing in regards to the STELA Reauthorization Act of 2014 (STELAR). We live in Carbon County in the state of Wyoming and subscribe to Direct TV. We have long been very dissatisfied that Wyoming PBS is not included in our satellite TV service.

We contribute tax dollars toward this station and have, in the past, supported Wyoming PBS with our direct contributions when we used to get reception on our old TV antenna. We are also unable to receive local severe weather warnings without access to Wyoming PBS. Our town has a population under 450 people and therefore no local severe weather detection and notification service.

In my opinion the "local into local" rule should be changed so that communities in Wyoming can have access to Wyoming PBS. Please, change this act so Wyoming residents can watch Wyoming PBS on their satellite systems. Thanks for the opportunity to comment.
