Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to notify you pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules and in connection with the above-referenced proceedings that on June 3, 2015 the undersigned from the Utilities Telecom Council met with David Furth, Zenji Nakazawa, Rasoul Safavian, Khouryanna Diprima, Kayla Gardner and Roberto Mussenden from the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Commission's rulemaking proposal to expand eligibility in the 4.9 GHz band (4940-4990 MHz) to include critical infrastructure industry (CII) entities, such as utilities. UTC reiterated its support for this proposal, and agreed with the Commission that the 4.9 GHz band could complement the 700 MHz Public Safety Broadband Network. Finally, UTC urged the Commission to quickly adopt rules that would make utilities and other CII entities eligible to access the 4.9 GHz band. The substance of the meeting was consistent with the comments of UTC on the record.
