As a broadcast engineer who has worked 40+ years in the industry and has constructed several LPFM stations, I know that translators have a huge advantage over LPFM because of the LP Height restrictions. The fact that an LPFM would need four times the power or twice the antenna height to achieve a reasonable coverage improvement makes the argument for 250 watts seem silly. Why not put LPFM stations on par with translators. Yes, please grant the 250 maximum power, but also lift the antenna height limitations for LPFM facilities. These vital, local mini stations deserve a break and certainly deserve to be on par with translators in every respect. I also think that LPFM stations should be able to replace translators if the station they rebroadcast does not originate programming within 100 miles of the translators location.
