Even with utilizing an outdoor type antenna we could not pull in a strong signal to monitor our on air signal. As of now we have a Mountain Top location that offers a pretty good on air signal for driving but the trade off is just about zero building penetration except for the few homes at the base of the mountain. Any opportunity to enhance and bring our local signal into more homes and or businesses would be welcomed.
