**Comments of
Colquitt Community Radio, Inc.**

Colquitt Community Radio, Inc. (CCR) holder of LPFM construction permit for WLOV-FM, Moultrie, Georgia and pursuant to the *Public Notice No, 3022 (released May 15, 2015)* hereby submits its comments in support of the proposal filed by REC Networks to increase the ERP of certain LPFM radio stations.

In fairness to the LPFM operators, the Commission should allow for an increase in power from 100 watts to 250 watts ERP as allowed by FM translators of which most, except those that re-broadcast a local AM station, do not provide any local programming. LPFM stations are required by law to provide a certain amount of local programming of which translators are not held to any local programming standard.

The technical part of the REC Networks proposal seems to be well thought out process and should not cause any increased interference to any operating full service station.

Based on the foregoing, CCR respectfully request the Commission to, without delay, open a formal rule making proceeding to improve the LPFM radio service.
