I am commenting on the STELA Reauthorization Act of 2014. I own a small campground in rural Wyoming and have both Direct TV and Dish Network. We have no cable provider available in our part of southern Carbon County in Wyoming. We cannot receive any TV stations off air as there are none close enough for us to receive their broadcasting. No Wyoming stations are provided by either Dish or Direct TV. The only local stations provided are all from Denver, CO. We do not receive any local Wyoming TV news. I would like to request the satellite providers give us access to at least Wyoming Public Television which is a taxpayer supported system. I would also like a local affiliate station from Casper or Cheyenne, Wyoming. We miss important emergency information as Denver emergencies don't really ever apply to our area, particularly we have vastly different weather systems. We also never receive any information during election cycles. I have no idea what's happening politically in our state, no updated legislative information is available. My biggest concern is, however, no access to Wyoming based emergency information. The 'local into local' rules should change so my satellite providers can include at the minimum Wyoming PBS for all Wyoming viewers. Thank you for this consideration.
