On June 9, 2015, Bob Quinn, on behalf of AT&T, met with Rebekah Goodheart of Commissioner Clyburn's office, via teleconference, to discuss the anticipated Lifeline Reform Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPRM) in the above referenced docket.

AT&T supports the Commission's efforts to continue modernizing the Lifeline program and in particular the proposal to remove Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETCs) from the administration of the program. AT&T also expressed consumer privacy concerns with the plan to require ETCs to begin retaining sensitive eligibility documentation.
