On June 11, 2015, I met with Jonathan Chambers, Director of Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis and Alok Doshi to discuss the Video Access Technology Reference Platform (VATRP) to discuss the possibilities and desired features for the the community to benefit from.

During the meeting, we discussed the following:

- Open source concept for independent programmers to build applications to be added to the product.
- Provide users with preferences while using VATRP and interpreters which includes routing calls to the next available interpreter to reduce the waiting time.
- Presenting the concept of VATRP as something the Deaf and Hard of Hearing communities owned in terms of platform development which includes applications / enhancements development.
- The long term vision of VATRP after several years
- Town hall meetings and communication with the community
- Porting options for users separately from the VATRP platform to provide an easier avenue for users to switch providers with address book, history, etc.

During the meeting, we also discussed the upcoming VRS with Canada to gain some insight in what may be successful or not when they have launched the VRS for Canada.
