The current range of the LP stations is so limited in some areas that it makes it difficult to engage the entire community - especially in rural or smaller areas. The range of the LP community station in Hot Springs Arkansas just takes it to the edge of the city limits. Yet much of the community lives in the county outside of the city limits - mostly in rural and small towns surrounding Hot Springs like Mountain Pine and Fountain Lake. There are only two school districts in the city of Hot Springs but there are about five districts surrounding Hot Springs. The school districts compete with one another and are connected in many other ways. If the LP station in Hot Springs could reach the other school districts, we could engage all of them in broadcasting - they could all create and broadcast programs, discussing what is happening at the respective schools. The EAST programs at the schools could use the station for EAST projects. Aside from the schools, each small community could become active in the station and have programs designed for their community with people from there community serving as DJ's and speakers. It would just take a small increase in the permitted wattage to reach this audience.
