On June 16, 2015, Dave Wright of Ruckus Wireless, Inc. ("Ruckus"), met with Louis Peraertz, Technology Advisor to Commissioner to Clyburn to discuss certain matters related to the above-captioned proceeding and current trends in LTE-U, LAA and LWA technology. During the meeting Ruckus reiterated its belief that a policy of airtime fairness in the 5 GHz unlicensed band was critical to protecting the investment and unprecedented success of Wi-Fi for wireless consumers, now and in the future. Establishing a policy of airtime fairness though, for example, listen-before-talk would further the Commission's desire to be technologically neutral.
