Dear Ms. Dortch:

Michael Gravino, Director of the LPTV Spectrum Rights Coalition, (the "Coalition"), met on June 15, 2015 with Valery Galasso, Media Advisor for FCC Commissioner Rosenworcel.

In our 10-minute meeting we provided Ms. Galasso, for the Commissioner, two posters (see attached) of LPTV and TV translator maps, to graphically show the 8000 LPTV, Class-A, and TV Translator licenses and new construction permits. The FCC Media Bureau, Video Division, generated two of the maps for the Coalition and one map was generated by the Coalition from its BIG MAP PROJECT.

We also gave Ms. Galasso a copy of the Coalition's 96-page *2015 LPTV Industry Directory* so she and the Commissioner could see the industry research we have generated to support our filings, and to better see the component parts of our industry.

Ms. Galasso listened to our concerns about the "*Amendment of Parts 15, 73 and 74 of the Commission's Rules to Provide for the Preservation of One Vacant Channel in the UHF Television Band For Use By Wireless Microphones and White Space Device*", submitted by Office of Engineering and Technology, and the Media Bureau.
