Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 2, 2014, the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) published an online map of submitted study area boundaries and announced procedures for filing revised study area boundary data.¹ The Bureau's *Public Notice* permits incumbent LECs to resolve overlaps through discussions with neighboring incumbent LECs.

Consistent with the *Public Notice*, Verizon has held discussions with the Ponderosa Telephone Company and has resolved the highlighted overlap with Ponderosa. In the highlighted overlap areas between Verizon California (study area code 542302) and the Ponderosa Telephone Company (study area code 542332), Verizon hereby modifies its study area boundary to follow the study area boundary submitted by the Ponderosa Telephone Company. I certify that the modified study area boundaries are accurate and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, based on a reasonable, good faith effort to confirm the accuracy of those boundaries.

As the Bureau recognized in the *Reconsideration Order*, any mapping information submitted by Verizon, including the modifications described in this letter, may be adjusted or corrected in future years.²
