The United States has one of the slowest and most expensive Internet services in the world. I am 62 and disabled, so I get \$753 a month from SSI and Social Security. I live in subsidized housing, and qualify for the Lifeline cell phone service, but Comcast charges me \$50.83 a month currently for my Internet-only service, with frequent price hikes whenever they want.

Chairman Wheeler has proposed subsidized Internet service for low-income households like mine, and I could really use the help. My Internet costs 2-1/2 times my electric bill every month presently. I look forward to the implementation of a low-cost broadband service so I can contact Federal agencies like HUD or Social Security when necessary. Thank you.
