Re: *Ex Parte* Notice: *Terrestrial Use of the 2473-2495 MHz Band for Low-Power Mobile Broadband Networks – IB Docket No. 13-213*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 26, 2015, Jay Monroe, Chairman of the Board of Directors and Chief Executive Officer of Globalstar, Inc. (“Globalstar”), spoke with Mindel De La Torre, Chief of the International Bureau, on June 29, 2015, Dennis Roberson, President and Chief Executive Officer of Roberson and Associates, LLC, spoke with Julius Knapp, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology, and on June 30, 2015, Dennis Roberson and I spoke with Jose Albuquerque, Chief of the International Bureau’s Satellite Division, to urge the Commission to adopt its proposed rules in the above-captioned proceeding. These rules would both maintain Globalstar’s licensed Mobile Satellite Service operations and permit Globalstar to provide low-power terrestrial mobile broadband service.

Globalstar’s representatives addressed technical and interference claims by opponents, many of whom are potential competitors. We noted that the March 2015 demonstration showed that Terrestrial Low Power Service was compatible with existing unlicensed operations. We also pointed out the inconsistency between opponents’ arguments and alleged concern about interference to Wi-Fi Channel 11 with their own proposals to operate on overlapping channels under new technical limits. We urged the Commission to reject the unsubstantiated technical and policy requests by these opponents.
