SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Charter Advanced Services (MO), LLC (“Charter Advanced Services”), through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, hereby files this Application to discontinue offering an interconnected VoIP service at a certain condominium development located in University City, Missouri (the “**Service Area**”).

In support of its Application, Charter Advanced Services submits the following information:

Name and address of carrier:

This Application is submitted by Charter Advanced Services (MO), LLC, whose address is 12405 Powerscourt Drive, St. Louis, Missouri 63131.

Date of planned service discontinuance:

Charter Advanced Services intends to discontinue offering the service described in this Application in the Service Area on August 15, 2015 or as soon thereafter as federal approval may be obtained.

Points of geographic areas of service affected:

Charter Advanced Services currently offers the service that is the subject of this Application to residential customers in locations including Loop Condos in University City, Missouri. Charter Advanced Services seeks authority to discontinue offering the service only at Loop Condos.

Brief description of type of service affected:

Charter Advanced Services proposes to discontinue offering residential interconnected VoIP service to new and existing customers residing in the Service Area. This service enables local and toll calling throughout the United States and Canada for a single monthly fee and the ability to place international calls for separate charges. Similar services are available in the Service Area from incumbent local exchange carriers and other telecommunications carriers and interconnected VoIP service providers.

Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers:

Charter Advanced Services mailed written notice on June 1, 2015 to its three (3) voice service customers in the Service Area, notifying them that as a result of Charter's agreement to provide Wi-Fi service to Loop Condos, their individual Charter high speed Internet service, if any, and subject to FCC approval, their voice service would be discontinued on August 1, 2015. While preparing this Application, Charter became aware that the June 1 notice incorrectly identified the provider of Charter cable and Internet service in the Service Area as the voice service provider. Charter prepared and mailed a notice on June 16, 2015 that correctly identified Charter Advanced Services as the voice service provider and stated that their voice service would be discontinued on August 15, 2015, but by that time all three customers had migrated to other voice service providers. As a result, no customers will be affected by this discontinuance of

Charter Advanced Services' interconnected VoIP service in the Service Area. Because no customer received a compliant discontinuance notice before disconnecting service, Charter Advanced Services is not submitting a customer notice with this Application.

Non-dominance of the carrier with respect to the service to be discontinued:

The service to be discontinued is an interconnected VoIP service. Accordingly, Charter Advanced Services is non-dominant with respect to the service as a matter of law.

Service:

In accordance with Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, Charter Advanced Services has mailed copies of this Application to the Governor of the State of Missouri, the Missouri Public Service Commission and the United States Secretary of Defense.

Conclusion

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of the offering of this service because comparable services are available from other providers in the market. Charter Advanced Services respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Section 63.71 Application of Charter Advanced Services to discontinue offering interconnected VoIP service to residents of Loop Condos in University City, Missouri.
