My name is Michele Bradley, and I am the General Manager at the Port of Tillamook Bay in Tillamook, Oregon. We have been part of Tillamook Lightwave with the goal of bringing broadband services to rural Oregon.

We have chosen a competitive carrier for our voice and data services. They provide the individualized services and customer support we need. Broadband services are a critical infrastructure for our Airport and Industrial Park. One of our tenants, Near Space Corporation, uses the services in their business, which is UAS/UAV testing, manufacturing of weather and other balloons, etc., with their main clients being the Federal Government - DOD, NOAA, and Departments of Military. Our Airport has direct reporting to the Federal Aviation Administration.

We commend the FCC's efforts to provide customers with more choices for broadband service. As technology transitions and more services move to IP based solutions, we encourage you to protect the wholesale access market. This will ensure that our ability to choose a competitive provider, based on factors including customer service and price, will remain intact.
