ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S REQUEST TO SERVE REQUESTS FOR ADMISSION

1. The Enforcement Bureau (Bureau) respectfully requests the opportunity to serve requests for admission in the above-captioned matter. By way of background, the Bureau originally served Requests for Admission of Facts (RFAs) on William L. Zawila (Mr. Zawila), Avenal Educational Services, Inc. (Avenal), Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. (Central Valley), H.L. Charles d/b/a Ford City Broadcasting (FCB), and Linda Ware d/b/a/ Lindsay Broadcasting (LB) on September 4, 2003. These RFAs were directed to many of the Issues designated in the Order to Show Cause, Hearing Designation Order, and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (HDO).¹ On September 12, 2003, Judge Steinberg stayed the proceeding.² Although Judge Steinberg indicated that the stay would not apply to the filing of responses to the Bureau's RFAs,³ it appears from the record that the parties failed to provide complete responses to these RFAs.

2. The Presiding Judge has now lifted the stay and indicated that "discovery can and should commence forthwith on all issues."⁴ Accordingly, the Bureau respectfully requests that it be permitted to serve renewed requests for admission on the parties concerning the Issues designated in the HDO with the expectation that these requests may narrow the scope of the factual discovery needed on these Issues. In addition, on June 18, 2015, the Bureau requested that the Presiding Judge enlarge the HDO to add two Issues.⁵ The Bureau's Motion is now fully


