Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 1, 2015, Barclay Knapp, Chief Executive Officer of Spectrum Networks Group, LLC (“SNG”), and Pantelis Michalopoulos and the undersigned from Steptoe & Johnson LLP met with Jessica Almond, Renee Gregory, and Gigi Sohn of Chairman Wheeler’s Office. We discussed the Application for Review filed by SNG following the Bureau’s denial of SNG’s waiver request and the dismissal of SNG’s applications for licenses in the 896-901/935-940 MHz band (“900 MHz I/B band”).

Specifically, we described numerous instances where the Bureau has granted license applications in the 900 MHz I/B band for applicants that, like SNG and its subsidiary M2M Spectrum Networks, LLC (“M2M”), serve or plan to serve third parties rather than use the spectrum for their own private internal communications needs. We requested that the Commission act quickly and affirmatively on the SNG Application for Review to correct this case of disparate treatment.

This summary of the *ex parte* presentation is being submitted pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission’s rules.¹ The letter is being filed electronically through the Commission’s Electronic Comment Filing System (“ECFS”), and electronic copies will also be sent to the Commission staff with whom we spoke.
