On July 6, 2015, Aparna Sridhar of Google Inc., Christopher Szymanski of Broadcom Corporation, Michael Daum of Microsoft Corporation, and I spoke via telephone with Erin McGrath, Legal Advisor for Commissioner O'Reilly. On July 7, 2015, the same group spoke via telephone with Valery Galasso, Policy Advisor for Commissioner Rosenworcel; David Strickland, Acting Legal Advisor for Commissioner Clyburn; and Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff for Commissioner Pai, Brendan Carr, Legal Advisor for Commissioner Pai, and Ben Sunshine, Intern for Commissioner Pai. We discussed the importance of access to low-frequency unlicensed spectrum and emphasized that a decision by the Commission to place broadcasters in the duplex gap in certain markets detracts from the goal of identifying three TV white space channels per market for consumers. We also explained how this decision relates to upcoming proceedings regarding the revised Part 15 technical rules, Channel 37, and remaining TV white spaces.
