Re: ***Notice of Ex Parte Presentation:*** Amendments of Parts 1, 21, 73, 74 and 101 of the Commission's Rules to Facilitate the Provision of Fixed and Mobile Broadband Access, Educational and Other Advanced Services in the 2150-2162 and 2500-2690 MHz Bands, WT Docket No. 03-66.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 8, 2015, Lawrence R. Krevor, Vice President, Legal and Government Affairs – Spectrum, Richard B. Engelman, Director, Legal and Government Affairs, and the undersigned of Sprint Corporation (“Sprint”), met with John Leibovitz, Sean Conway, Blaise Scinto, John Schauble and Nancy Zaczek of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-captioned proceeding.

At this meeting, FCC Staff and Sprint discussed the possibility of a Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that would address a number of open issues in this proceeding, including the June 6, 2014 “Consensus Proposal” of the National EBS Association (“NEBSA”), the Wireless Communications Association International (“WCAI”), and the Hispanic Information and Telecommunications Network, Inc. (“HITN”) for licensing currently unlicensed Educational Broadband Service (“EBS”) “white space” spectrum. We also discussed other possible changes and/or updates to FCC rules, and whether other EBS rules required modernization. Sprint also provided an overview of how it utilizes its 2.5 GHz spectrum today to provide broadband service to its customers and outlined its future plans for the densification of its network in this spectrum band.
