Dear Ms. Dortch:

AT&T respectfully requests that its referenced Petition for Waiver (“Petition”) be submitted for expedited review pursuant to Commission rule section 1.925(b)(4). As stated in AT&T’s Petition, AT&T and its competitors are rapidly deploying IP-based calling solutions. Specifically, at least two of AT&T’s competitors have deployed and are widely advertising Wi-Fi calling across their networks.¹ AT&T hopes to begin to offer its own Wi-Fi calling service later this year, but for the reasons specified in its Petition, requires a waiver of current rules. The failure to grant the waiver on an expedited basis risks placing AT&T at a long-term competitive disadvantage. For these reasons, AT&T respectfully requests that the Commission consider its Petition for expedited review and establish a comment cycle to accomplish same.
