Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 1, 2015, the Commission issued a Public Notice seeking comment on the above-captioned applications. Comments and petitions to deny were due on July 1, 2015, and responses are due today. To date, only two parties submitted comments. The Department of Justice, on behalf of “Team Telecom,” submitted a customary letter requesting the Commission defer final action on the applications pending completion of the national security, law enforcement, and public safety review by Team Telecom. LightSquared separately has responded to Team Telecom’s requests for information and is in active discussion with Team Telecom to enable them to complete their review in a timely manner. The other comment was filed by the National Association of Broadcasters, and it specifically takes no position on the above-captioned applications but seeks to make a point about foreign investment in broadcast licensees.¹

In light of the clear public interest benefits, as documented in the applications, that will be realized by approval of the license transfer and the petition for declaratory ruling, and the lack
