The Crow Creek Sioux Tribe hereby requests an eighteen (18) month extension of time to construct a low-power FM radio station ("Request"). The Crow Creek Sioux Tribe was issued a Construction Permit on February 4, 2014 to construct a low-power FM radio station with an expiration date of August 4, 2015. The Crow Creek Sioux Tribe has been working diligently to develop the capabilities and funding to construct and operate a low-power FM radio station to serve the communications needs of Tribal members and residents of the Crow Creek reservation, but needs additional time to complete design and construction. The public interest, and the Tribal interest, would be greatly served by granting an extension of time to construct a low-power FM radio station, which will serve the unique needs of Tribal members and residents of the Crow Creek reservation, because the Construction Permit allows the Crow Creek Sioux Tribe, for the very first time, to provide a communications medium for Tribal culture, education, and development on the Crow Creek reservation.
