Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 9, 2015, ITTA filed a confidential and redacted version of a PowerPoint presentation ITTA and others made to Wireline Competition Bureau staff on July 7, 2015 regarding a proposed build-out methodology for a voluntary, model-based universal service support plan for rate-of-return carriers.¹ We submitted the presentation pursuant to the terms of the Third Supplemental Protective Order adopted in this proceeding in an abundance of caution to protect potentially confidential data included on slides six and seven.²

It has since been determined that it is permissible to file the presentation publicly because the census block numbers included on slide six are fictitious and are in no way tied to the census blocks in the A-CAM to which they correspond. The information included on slide seven likewise does not require redactions because the Commission made that information publicly available in the A-CAM illustrative results. Therefore, with this letter, we are submitting an unredacted version of the presentation into the docket.
