Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

In connection with the deployment of fiber distribution facilities throughout its service area, Terril Telephone Cooperative is converting all facilities at its above-identified Central Office to fiber to the home (FTTH) network architecture. Following this transition, interconnection at the Terril, Iowa CO must be via fiber facilities.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

After the cut to the DLC, copper reliant services such as non-loaded copper loops will not be supported. All other types of unbundled loops will still be available.

Notice to Connecting Carriers Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 51.333(a):

There are currently no telephone exchange service providers that directly interconnect with Terril Telephone Cooperative. The change will therefore not result in discontinuance, reduction or impairment of any service to any connecting carrier.
