On July 14, 2015, Michael Olsen, Lee Schroeder, Emmett O'Keefe, and Alexi Maltas of Cablevision Systems Corporation, Justin Lilley of TeleMedia Policy Corp., and the undersigned met with William Lake, Nancy Murphy, Julie Shursky, and Raelynn Remy. In the meeting, Cablevision discussed the Commission's proceeding on retransmission consent. Consistent with its comments, Cablevision argued that the Commission should level the retransmission-consent playing field by clarifying broadcasters' duty to negotiate in good faith.<sup>1</sup>
