I would like to bring to attention of the FCC the following quote from the ex parte filed by Greg Gerst of Gerst Capital on July 16, 2015:

Regarding the final quote above, it is ironic that Globalstar's paid lobbyist, Blair Levinson, refers to "sound engineering" when a straightforward engineering analysis clearly raises doubts that TLPS will be "compatible with existing services".

For Mr. Gerst to misspell the name of a man that was Chief of Staff for a former FCC Chairman and was Executive Director of the National Broadband Plan is, in my opinion, very disrespectful.
