On July 16, 2015 Joel Bernstein (SMS/800, Inc.) met via telephone with Roland Helvajian (Office of Managing Director), and Mika Savir (Enforcement Bureau) to discuss the logistics of submitting information requested by the Commission to implement Commission's new fees on Toll-free numbers (TFNs).

In particular, we discussed how to treat the confidentiality of some of Resp Org information necessary for the Commission to set up fee payer accounts and generate bills for Resp Orgs. We discussed whether the submission should be part of the record of this proceeding and decided that SMS/800, Inc. would file a redacted version in this proceeding.

We also discussed the logistics and timing of the Commission's bills and the Resp Org's abilities to bill customers to recover the new TFN fee. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any further questions.
