Dear Ms. Dortch:

KSQA, LLC, licensee of television station KSQA, Topeka, Kansas ("KSQA"), by its attorneys, hereby advises the Commission that the negotiations between KSQA and DirecTV, LLC have terminated without the parties reaching a settlement of the above-referenced carriage complaint.

Pursuant to the letter from the Media Bureau, Policy Division, the comment cycle in this proceeding was held in abeyance to allow the parties to pursue settlement negotiations.¹ The Bureau letter stated that the 120-day deadline for the Commission to resolve satellite carriage complaints would be tolled during the pendency of the settlement negotiations, and the Bureau would restart the clock if the parties were unable to reach a settlement.


