Reasons for Reconsideration:

It is our belief that the commission overlooked the school's key argument in their grounds for appeal. The main argument was that the school committed a ministerial and clerical error in listing the actual contract signing date instead of the allowable contract date. This type of error clearly falls under the precedent set in *Request for Review of the Decision of the Universal Service Administrator by Bishop Perry Middle School, et al., Schools and Libraries Universal Service Support Mechanism, File No. SLD-487170, CC Docket No. 02-6, Order, 21 FCC Rcd 5316, 5326-27, para. 23 (2006) (Bishop Perry Order)*.

All vendors chosen were awarded the contract on the allowable contract date after considering all other bids over the 28 day period. This decision was memorialized and there was a straightforward M&C error committed on the Form 471. The correct contract award date for all above mentioned FRNs is the allowable contract date.

We therefore submit that the Calhoun School has met all contract requirements and that all FRNS should be FUNDED or else the school will experience undue hardship that goes counter to the goals of the E-rate program.
